

Reading Promotional Strategy





Book Club



I propose starting a Book Club that meets for lunch once a month with each group.

There will be 3 groups.



Target Audience



- 1st graders will not be able to join till after Christmas, to allow for some extra reading fluency practice in class
- 3rd and 4th grade, The Budding Bookworms (BB2)
- 5th, The Blazing Bookworms (BB3)
 - Participation in Book Club will be on a volunteer basis and student will have certain responsibilities



Time Frame

- Groups will only meet once a month and the day may change according to Librarians schedule (BB1 1st week of the month, BB2 2nd week of the month, BB3 3rd week of the month)
- The groups will begin meeting the 2nd month of school and continue until the next to last month (September to April)
- Lunch will last 40 minutes, so that students only miss a total of 10 minutes of classroom instructional time, with the exception of Christmas and the last meeting. They will come to the library 10 minutes before their lunch is to start and we will proceed from there. Christmas and at the last meeting would last 60 90 minutes.
- During Book Club time, student will have 15-20 minutes to eat their lunch and then we will spend the last 20-25 minutes discussing the book.



Resources Needed

- 🔷 Human Resources
 - Librarian needed to direct book talk and be official school sponsor
 - 1 other adult volunteer –need to help keep students organized and aid librarian as needed
- Print Resources
 - Books chosen to be used in Book Club (could use some type of eReader for each student)
